There is also scope for delivery of diocesan training.

Possessing a social work qualification or similar, you will have experience of child or adult safeguarding as a senior practitioner and/or manager. You will have knowledge of current legislation relating to safeguarding practice, and demonstrate a good understanding of the structure and operation of statutory and voluntary bodies involved in safeguarding.
