Croydon Heritage Festival

Events at the Minster are as follows:

Saturday 24th June, 4pm: Concert – By popular demand, another chance to hear "Minster Blaze," a specially-commissioned work on the devastating fire of 1867, written and performed by Martin How (piano), with Tom Little (organ) and Paul Wilson (orator), plus a selection of additional songs and readings combined with a picture slide show about the fire.

Sunday 25th June, 6.30pm: Festal Evensong – A traditional choral evensong sung by the Choir of Men and Boys.

Monday 26th to Friday 30th June: Exhibition – The story of the fire of 1867 (150 years ago this year), which almost destroyed the church. Open 11am-4pm daily except Thursday, in the Mary Chapel.

Monday 26th (11am), Tuesday 27th (2pm), Friday 30th (1pm): Tours – War and Peace; an Evolution, history tours of the Minster led by David Morgan.

Tuesday 27th June, 3pm: Talk – River, Church, Almshouse: the history of Croydon's medieval almshouse charity, by Sue Turnbull and Karen Ip. Venue: Minster Hall.
