Focus on the Creation and the Environment As part of our focus on the Creation and Environment from 1st September – incorporating the Feast of St Francis of Assisi on 4th October and culminating in our Harvest Festival on Sunday 6th October – you are welcome to two forthcoming events which follow on from the 7pm Thursday Choral Evensong (to which all are welcome):

St Francis & The Sultan Thursday 26th September. It will involve showing part of the film 'Francis and the Sultan' which is a drama portraying the meeting between St Francis and the Sultan Al Kamil that took place during the crusades in 1219. It is one of the earliest documented Interfaith encounters. This will be followed by an Interfaith panel discussion based on the film and shared

refreshments. (This event is jointly organised by the Minster and The Third Order Franciscans through Fr Alan Bayes (a Franciscan Tertiary). As it is the season of creation and there is the link with the Franciscans we hope that the Interfaith discussions will focus on environmental themes.

Laudatio Si Thursday 3rd October. An evening introducing Pope Francis' Encyclical Letter *Laudatio Si: Care for our Common Home*, addressed to all Christians (not just Roman Catholics!) which offers a Christian critique of how we are currently treating the environment. The evening will introduce the key themes of the letter and consider how we might respond. *Please sign up if you would like to come to both or either events.*
